Arbor

At Summerhill we use Arbor to track many aspects of your child's time at school. Via the Parent Portal you can view your child's basic details, timetable, attendance and behaviour statistics, termly reports and receive notifications regarding detentions, update information on your child's profile and much more!

You will receive an email inviting you to join Arbor. Once you have logged in please:

1. Check your child's basic details and add other required information such as Name, Gender, Address, Ethnicity, Country of Birth
2. Add a minimum of two priority contacts
3. Add meal and travel arrangements
4. Add Medical details (GP and any medical conditions)
5. Update the Consents

Registration

Please ensure that your child is in school around 08:35-08:40. Students should enter the school via the main Reception doors and will be directed to the main school hall. Please be considerate and patient if you use the school car park to drop off or collect.

Uniform

Students should come to school on Monday wearing their Primary School PE kit as we will be doing some house challenges. On Tuesday students will be required to come in their current Primary School uniform.

Lunchtime

Students may bring a packed lunch with them to eat at lunchtime and a snack for break time. Alternatively, they can purchase food from the café, which will be a choice of a hot meal of the day, jacket potatoes, pasta or a selection of sandwiches. Payment for the induction days will be cash, please try to send near correct change. We encourage students to carry a water bottle, which can be filled at breaktimes. We are a nut-free school so please check any food brought onsite.

End of School

Students will finish their induction days at 2:30pm and will be allowed to make their own way home. If students need to wait for a sibling to walk home, we will have a safe space in the hall to wait.

Induction Evening

The induction evening will be held on Tuesday 2nd July 2024 and comprises a talk from members of the Senior Leadership Team, including the Heads of House.

The 'Welcome Talk' will be delivered twice one at 6pm and the other at 7pm which enables all parents and carers to attend. This has been arranged to give equal numbers in each session, so please do not be concerned if you hear of parents attending at a different time. It is not necessary for students to attend these talks, as they will have received the information during their Induction Visit. You will be communicated out in due course which time we would like you to attend.

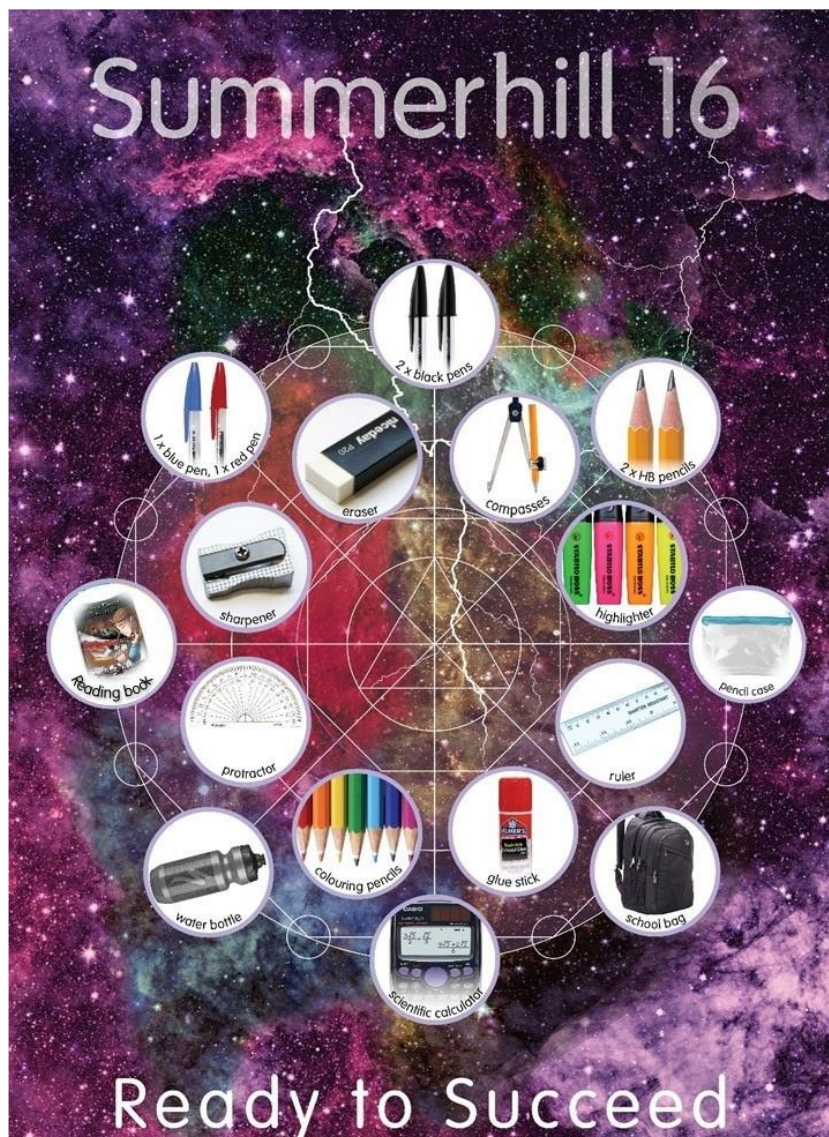

Our school uniform was designed together with students and their parents; we thank them for their helpful contribution.

We believe that learning the essential life skill of knowing how to dress smartly and with pride, is an important part of education. We also believe that correct equipment demonstrates organisation and readiness to learn.



- Navy blazer with House colour lining and House colour school logo
- Full length tie in House colour with fine navy and grey stripes (tie must reach waistband)
- Navy jumper with House colour trim around the neckline (jumper is optional if additional warmth is desired)
- Mid grey formal trousers, skirt or shorts *
Skirt, trousers and shorts must be tailored and not jersey or stretch material. Skirts can be straight or pleated. Skirts must be an appropriate length, no shorter than 6cm above the knee *
- White collared shirt that can be buttoned up to the neck and is of a length so that it is kept tucked in. Shirt must be suitable to wear with a tie *
- Black school shoes that can be polished not trainers or trainer style.
- Heels to be no higher than 4 cm *
- Black or navy tights *
- Black or navy socks (no white) *
