Photographs and video recording

Steps will be taken to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes they are intended. If you need clarification or are concerned about the use of your child's image please contact the school. You do have the right to withdraw consent at any time by writing to the Headteacher.

If you give permission for images to be used then it is possible that a third party may identify your child without your consent or knowledge.
